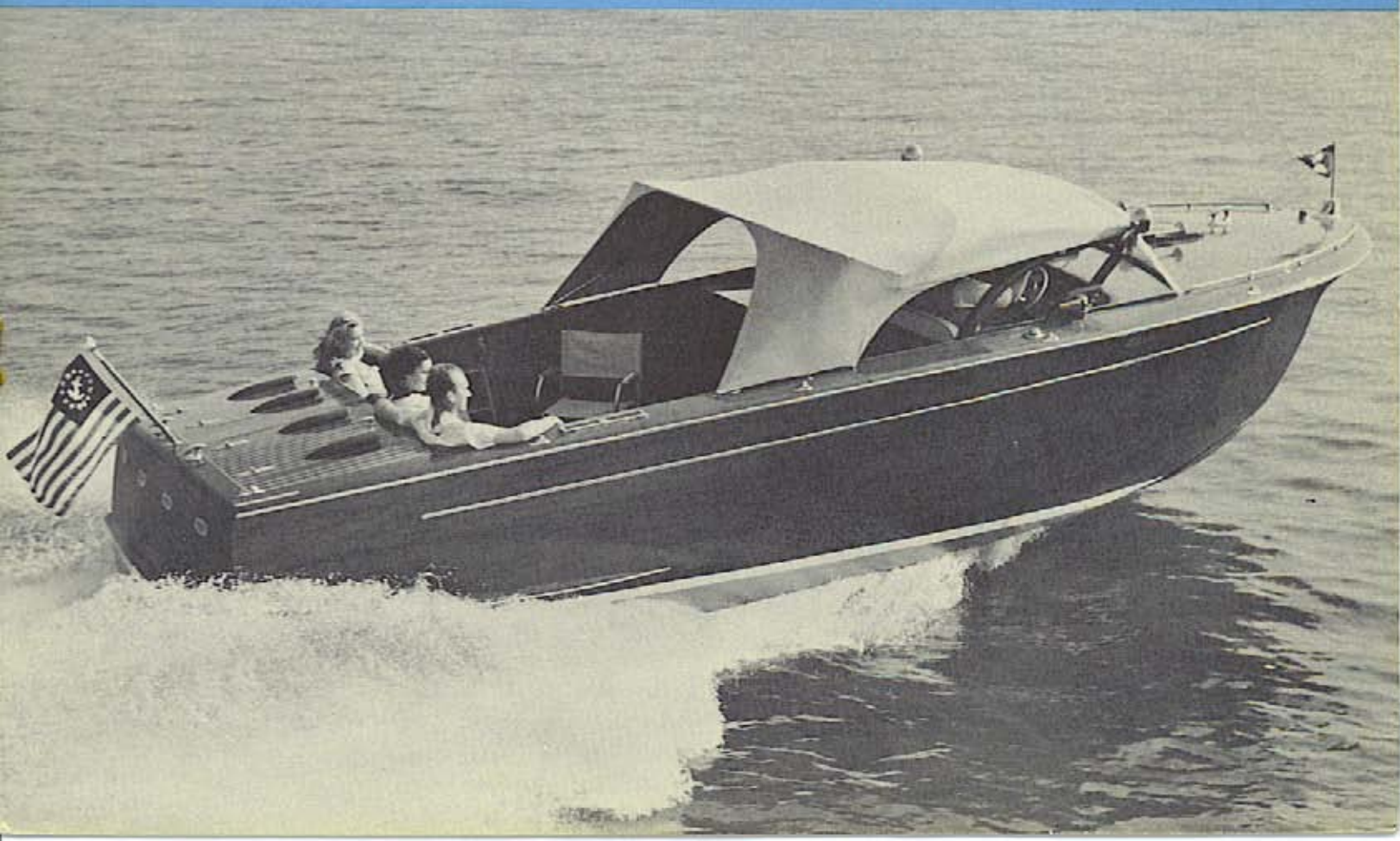

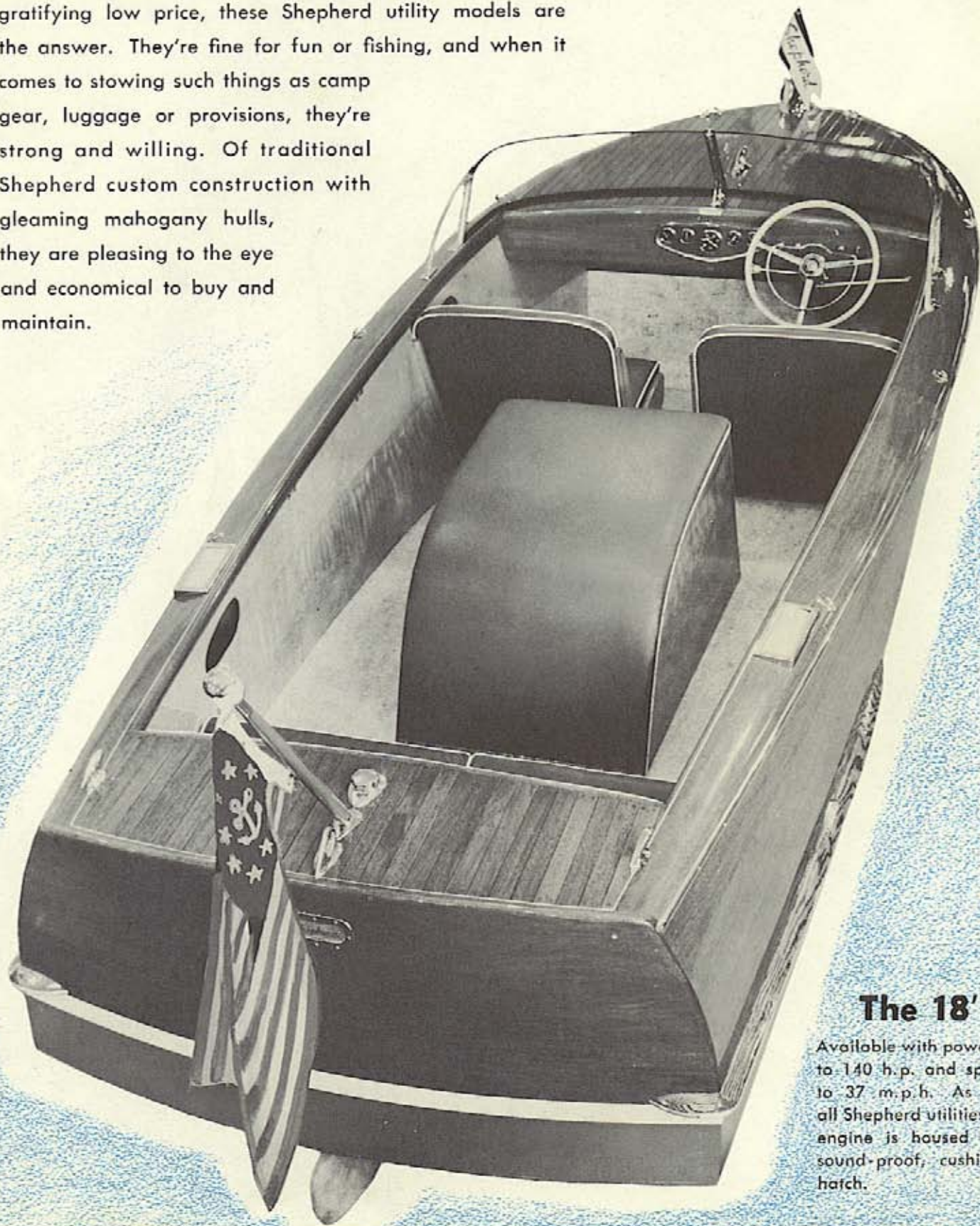

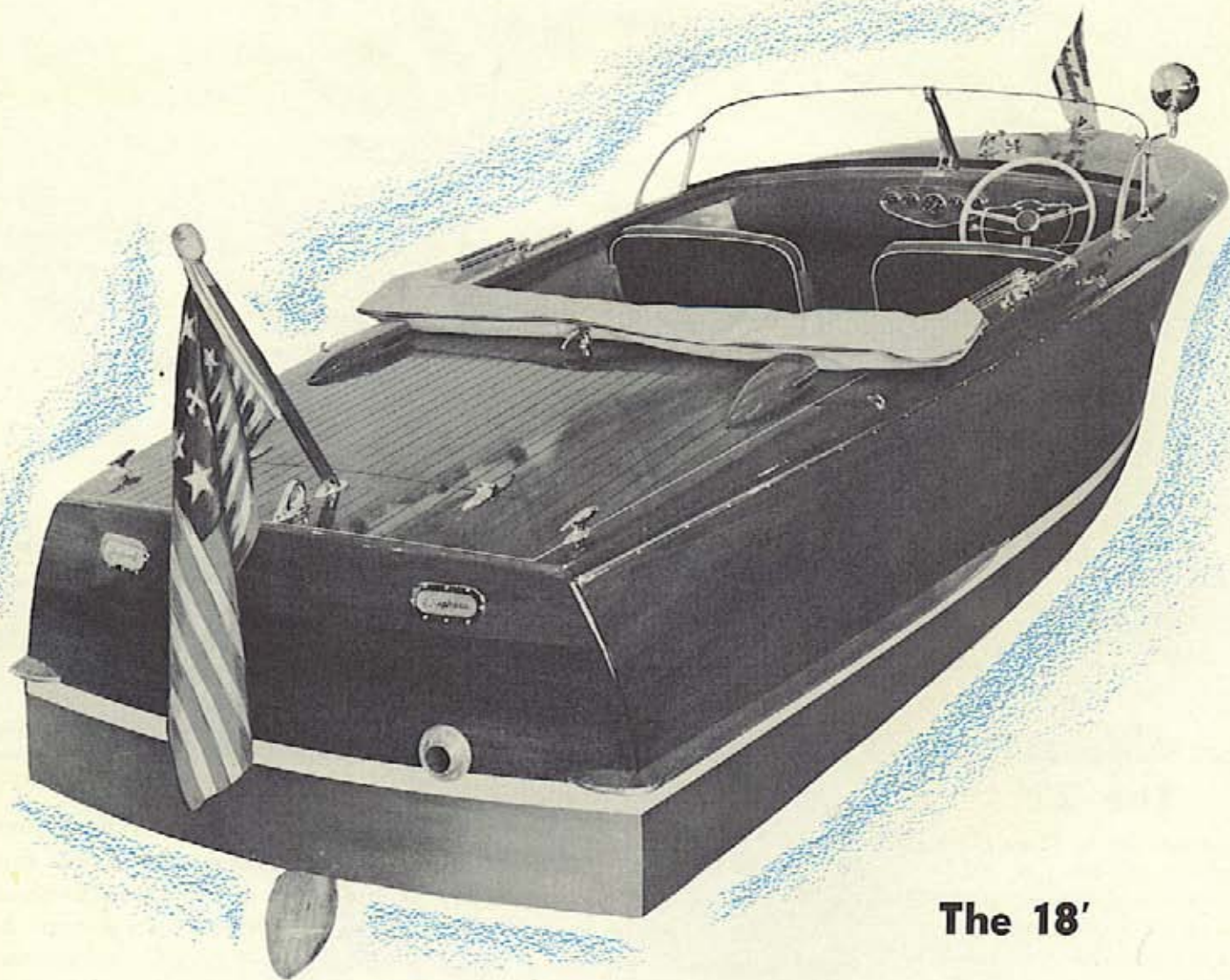


This shows the seats, wheel, instrument panel and mold-curved windshield which are the same on all 18' and 22' Shepherd direct-drive utilities.

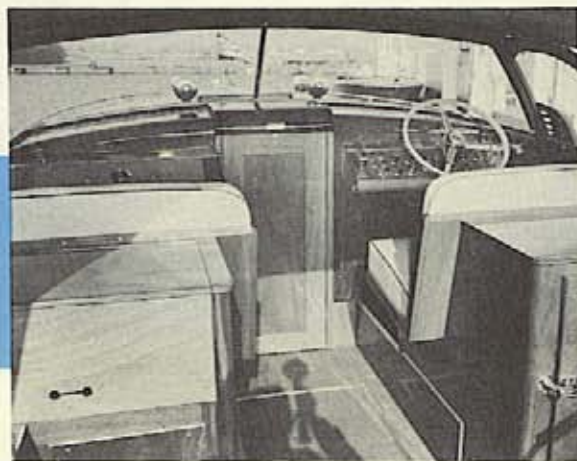
